The project: clean water for the school!

Health and hygiene also begin in Benin - which today, like the rest of the world, is dealing with Covid-19 - with clean water. The Foundation has therefore given top priority to providing 50 schools in the Borgou region (central Benin) with basic services for hygiene and potable water. We already installed wells for some thirty schools in recent years. They were drilled by local contractors. Now we want to tackle the remaining schools.

A well must be 85 meters deep on average, and costs around 7000 euros. That depth guarantees not only the quality of the water, but also an adequate permanent supply of water. We also want to build toilet blocks. And 'tippy taps', simple installations made of recycled material with which pupils can regularly wash their hands.

In short, basic infrastructure that can save the lives of school children and their fellow villagers. If we succeed, we will improve hygiene and drinking water supplies for more than 6,500 pupils and teachers and for a population of around 45,000 people. For the next phase of that project, the Foundation will need about €60,000 in funding.
